SAFETY IN CHURCH: Thanks to the help of our volunteers and the cooperation of everyone, we have done well in keeping people safe. Remember that if you develop symptoms of Covid and have been in close proximity to others for a period of 10-15 minutes in or outside church you should inform those persons and also apply for a test, self-isolating if the test is positive. By sanitising hands, wearing a face covering in church and keeping 2 meters from those not from your own household we should avoid infection. Do not attend church if you are unwell As you approach Communion lower face coverings, also for reading at Mass. No more than 6 people allowed to be together outside.

EXIT/ENTRANCE: Because of essential installation work for the church boiler the sacristy porch, top right hand side, is **NOT TO BE USED FOR THE TIME BEING.** Those on the sacristy side of the church, (centre right and right side aisle), should follow directions to leave by the porch door at the back of church after receiving Holy Communion. Please do not enter and leave church by the same door.
