A REMINDER TO TAKE CARE IN CHURCH : Every opportunity should be taken to stay safe and keep others safe by social distancing and sanitising hands, as well as wearing a face covering in church. The face covering may be lowered if you are a Reader and as you approach Communion which must be received in the hand. Volunteers are kindly helping to guide people to benches and to sanitise benches and surfaces after Mass. More helpers welcome. There rotas at the back of church if you wish to sign up to help. Thank you to all who are doing so.

COLLECTIONS: there are boxes at each door, on entry and exit for any Mass intentions, offertory envelopes and any other donations to church. The normal collection procedure during Mass is not allowed at the moment. Envelopes may also be put through the presbytery door. It would be important to sanitise any items before placing them in the box or the door.

CAFOD: We should not forget the needs of others far worse off than ourselves and whose provision through the Charities is less than it was. A collection box for Cafod is in the sacristy porch as you leave, or donations can be made to us at the presbytery.
